

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE
OF CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY POWER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **California Community Power**, pursuant to the authority vested in it by section 87306 of the Government Code, proposes approval of its conflict of interest code. A comment period has been established commencing on [DATE], 2022 and closing on [DATE], 2022. All inquiries should be directed to the contact listed below.

Any interested person may submit written comments relating to the proposed code by submitting them no later than [DATE], 2022, or at the conclusion of the public hearing, if requested, whichever comes later. At this time, no public hearing is scheduled. A person may request a hearing no later than [DATE], 2022.

California Community Power has determined that the proposed code:

1. Imposes no mandate on local agencies or school districts.
2. Imposes no costs or savings on any state agency.
3. Imposes no costs on any local agency or school district that are required to be reimbursed under Part 7 (commencing with Section 17500) of Division 4 of Title 2 of the Government Code.
4. Will not result in any nondiscretionary costs or savings to local agencies.
5. Will not result in any costs or savings in federal funding to the state.
6. Will not have any potential cost impact on private persons, businesses or small businesses.
