Mr. Morris reported a contact was signed with GDS Associates, Inc. for a strategic assessment of the Resource Adequacy power pool.

Mr. Morris presented on the work-planning approach to guide the budgeting process and reviewed the potential of using Master Service Agreements (MSA). Mr. Morris invited questions from the Board. Director Padilla suggested the resource planning working group evaluate the MSA strategy before bringing it to the Board. Directors Mitchell and Chang provided comments.

ii. <u>New Member Considerations – Updates</u>.

Mr. Morris provided an update on the written input received from the Board on new member considerations. Chair Syphers suggested postponing new member consideration. Directors Mitchell, Padilla, Chang, and Shaw agreed with the suggestion.

#### Subject: 2025 Board Officer Elections

Pursuant to Section 4.06 of the California Community Power ("CC Power") Joint Powers Agreement ("JPA"), at its first meeting in each calendar year, the Board of Directors shall elect or re-elect a Chair, a Vice-Chair, a Secretary, and a Treasurer/Controller.

#### **Description of Officer Positions**

<u>Chair:</u> The duties of the Chair shall be to preside over the Board meetings, sign all ordinances, resolutions, contracts and correspondence adopted or authorized by the Board, and to help ensure the Board's directives and resolutions are carried out. The Chair shall be selected from among the Directors.

<u>Vice-Chair:</u> In the absence or inability of the Chair to act, the Vice-Chair shall act as Chair. The Vice-Chair shall be selected among the Directors.

<u>Treasurer/Controller:</u> One person may hold both the office of Treasurer and the office of the Controller of CC Power. The Treasurer shall be the depository of CC Power to have custody of all the money of CC Power, from whatever source. The Controller shall draft warrants to pay demand against CC Power when the demands have been approved by the Chair or Vice-Chair. The Treasurer/Controller shall cause an independent audit to be made by a certified public accountant, or public accountants, in compliance with Section 6505 of the Government Code. The Treasurer/Controller may, but need not, be selected from among the Directors.

<u>Secretary:</u> The Secretary shall be responsible for keeping the minutes of all meetings of the Board and all other official records of CC Power and responding to public records requests of the JPA. The Secretary may, but need not, be selected from among the Directors.

#### **Nomination Process**

The first meeting of 2025 is currently expected to take place on Wednesday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>. At that meeting, the Board will vote to fill the above Officer positions. In order to facilitate the vote, any Directors who wish to be considered for one or more of the above positions, or who wish to nominate another Director for one or more of the above positions should email the current CC Power Chair and General Counsel. All nominations will be presented at the January 22<sup>nd</sup> Board Meeting for discussion and election.

#### **Recommended Action:**

Approve CC Power to negotiate and execute a purchase agreement for a 2025 Resource Adequacy report, in accordance with any not-to-exceed amounts, if agreed to by members, and to allocate applicable costs through a participating member cost-share agreement

#### Discussion:

CC Power members may at times benefit from joint-action, shared services, and bulkpurchases. CC Power member-CCAs may at times purchase reports, and information services, training, or other materials and services as part of their ongoing power procurement functions and related operations. Bulk purchases of such items can often yield material cost-savings for interested members.

In November 2024, staff at CC Power members, primarily staff associated with Resource Planning and the Resource Planning Working Group (RPWG), were contacted by CC Power regarding a potential bulk purchase of a report on Resource Adequacy. This expense was included in the 2024-2025 approved budget and work-plan. CC Power had previously bulk-purchased the 2024 version of this report in December 2023, yielding >20% cost-savings.

CC Power seeks Board Approval to execute a bulk-purchase of a Resource Adequacy report following RPWG recommendations. This Resolution, if approved, authorizes the CC Power General Manager or his or her designee to negotiate a bulk purchase of a RA report and to allocate applicable costs pro-rata among participating members. These costs would not impact General & Administrative (G&A) costs and would be categorized as project expenses shared among project participants. Participation is optional for each member, and non-participating members will have no incremental costs due to this effort. As appropriate, the motion includes a not-to-exceed amount.

Subject: Bulk Purchase – North American Energy Market Information Services, Reports, and Data Sets

#### **Recommended Action:**

Approve CC Power to pursue, negotiate and execute a purchase contract for relevant North American energy market information services, reports, and data sets, in accordance with any not-to-exceed amount, if agreed to be shared by members, and to allocate applicable costs through a participating member cost-share agreement

#### Discussion:

CCAs routinely purchases reports and data sets from vendors. Bulk-purchases of these types of information services may materially reduce costs for members. Depending on the nature of the reports, data sets, or services, costs per purchase can exceed \$100k.

CC Power previously bulk-purchased an information service with included technology reports and data sets for members for the 2024 calendar year, reducing member costs by over 60% per member.

CC Power is now again seeking cost-savings for members through a bulk-purchase of this nature. CC Power has engaged with members' procurement staff to solicit for potential interest and pricing considerations.

CC Power has now identified a qualified vendor, and CC Power and member-staff are actively considering the offerings and potential pricing. Staff foresees that six or more members are likely interested and will consider participation.

The 2024-2025 budget included estimates for this type of bulk purchase, and staff now recommends the Board authorize a not-to-exceed of \$125,000 for these purchases, in line with the budget. Costs per member will be significantly less than the total not-to-exceed.

While not final, we estimate that the following table shows potential or expected cost-savings per member.
