

California Community Power Issues Request for Proposals: Project Development Playbook

Proposals due September 25, 2026

September 1, 2026 – California Community Power (“CC Power”), a joint powers agency comprising of nine community choice aggregators (“CCAs”) serving over 2.7 million customers and 31,000 GWh annually across California, today issued a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) to enter into a services agreement with a consultant to complete a “Project Development Playbook”.

CC Power is issuing this RFP to retain a qualified consultant to create a Playbook for the development of a generic greenfield solar plus storage project in the CAISO that is intended to serve as:

1. An actionable guide on the process, workstreams, subject matter experts, costs, and risks across each of the various phases of a project’s lifecycle to improve CC Power’s members’ understanding of the development process;
2. Informing a go / no-go assessment by each of CC Power’s members as to whether to approve a greenfield development effort and/or inform the diligence and potential purchase of a mid-stage development project for CC Power’s completion and ownership thereof; and
3. A playbook for CC Power to utilize in undertaking actual project development.

Respondents are encouraged to read the RFP Instructions and submission instructions for more details on the eligibility requirements for participation.
